



In order to efficiently move cargo through our port terminals, LOGISTEC uses equipment that requires fuel in our daily operations. In the current context and as fuel prices fluctuate, a surcharge is applied to offset the cost of fuel used.

## CALCULATING FUEL SURCHARGE

LOGISTEC's fuel surcharge is metric tonne-based (MT). It is calculated quarterly using the national average retail prices of diesel from both the <u>U.S. Energy Information Administration</u> and <u>Natural Resources Canada</u>. The base starting rate is \$1.30/litre - \$3.30/gallon.

## Example:

For a US shipment of 500 MT handled by LOGISTEC in May 2022, the fuel surcharge is based on the average price for February 2022 which was 4.03/gallon at a rate of 0.20 (Tier 2) per MT: 0.20 Fig. 100 USD fuel surcharge.
