Port Hawkesbury Pier is located in the Town of Port Hawkesbury, on the eastern side of the Strait of Canso. This L-shaped pier is adjacent to the Strait of Canso Yacht Club. offers 5 to 6 metre depths along the wharf face, and provides excellent berth space for service vessels, tugs, barges, and pilot boats.



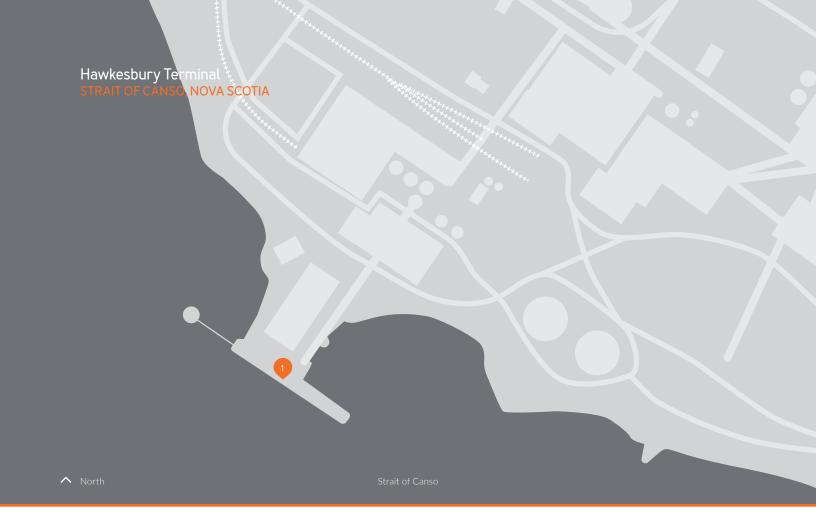
