

# Baie Comeau

## Quebec

The Baie-Comeau Terminal is a key multimodal hub on the St. Lawrence River. Strategically positioned at the intersection of Quebec Routes 138 and 389, it features a rail ferry connection to the CN rail network via Matane, providing access to domestic and international markets.

With deep-water berths for Panamax-class vessels year-round, the terminal reliably handles over 6 million tonnes of cargo annually, including aluminum, grain, and forest products. Ongoing investments aim to modernize the terminal, focusing on redeveloping Terminal No. 5 and implementing green energy initiatives. The Baie-Comeau Terminal remains a crucial gateway for trade and innovation in Eastern Canada.
